



RCR Face-to-Face Training: Lab Specific Training TrainTraq Course 2114651

As detailed in TAMU SAP 15.99.99.M0.04 Responsible Conduct of Research, four hours of face-to-face (F2F) training is required for graduate students participating in externally funded research and all postdoctoral researchers. Individuals may receive **one hour** of RCR F2F credit if they meet the following criteria: **The Principal Investigator for the laboratory (or their designee) provides at least one hour of in-person training specific to the activities performed in the space.**

Lab Specific Training suggested topics:

- Laboratory Safety Training (examples include):
 - Security
 - Electrical/fire safety
 - Safe Lab Practices
 - Chemical/Physical hazards
 - Waste disposal
- Biosafety training specific to the lab
- Human subjects or animal use training specific to lab
- Training on lab specific equipment
- Record/data management
- Promoting a safe environment for all members
